4. What are the consequences if we say that culture has authority over the Bible versus the Bible having authority over culture?
5. When have you seen someone respond well after being confronted about an inappropriate behavior or practice? What might have happened if the person was never confronted?
6. What role does our identity (what we believe about ourselves) play in how we live our lives?
7. How can our Christian identity (child of God, holy, blameless, perfect, secure, etc.) become more of what we believe about ourselves? What difference might it make?
