1 Corinthians 8 & 10

1. Do you tend to focus more on making sure people agree with you or on the relationship with those people? Have you always been this way? If not, what changed?
2. What is difficult about focusing on both right versus wrong and relationships? Why are both needed?
3. What current debates (in culture or in the church) have the possibility of ending relationships? Is it worth it? Why or why not?
4. When did a debate cost you a relationship? Was it worth it? Why or why not?
5. When have you been befriended by someone who saw the world differently than you? What effect did it have on you?
6. Who is one person (or one type of person) that you tend to avoid because they disagree with you on an important issue? What would it look like to embrace this person relationally without compromising your beliefs?
7. To what extent does Jesus' embrace of us (when we are wrong) motivate you to do the same?
